

WHERE WILL WE BE?

The Forum will take place in Los Angeles, California, USA, in the Canoga Park/Woodland Hills area of the San Fernando Valley. Pre- and post-conference activities (workshops) will take place on Thursday, March 30th, and Friday, March 31st, and on Monday, April 3rd, and Tuesday, April 4th, at United Technologies' Pratt & Whitney Rocketdyne's offices at 6633 Canoga Avenue in Canoga Park. Conference activities will begin on Friday afternoon at 4:00pm and extend through Sunday at 12:00pm – all to be held at the nearby Hilton Woodland Hills (6360 Canoga Avenue, Woodland Hills).
