CSUN Parking Information

Parking is available \$6 per day, and is valid until midnight.

Parking Permits

Parking Permits are available at kiosks in certain parking lots on campus (see Parking Map at <http://www.in2in.org/forums/2013/2013Forum-CSUNMaps.pdf> for locations).

- 3-day parking permits can be purchased at kiosks in the G9 parking lot within the dormitory area. 1-day parking permits can be purchased at Kiosks in the G3 parking lot.
- Parking permits can be purchased for a maximum duration of 3-days at one time.
- Parking permits can be purchased at any kiosk on campus, but are only available for one (1) day at other locations.
- Parking permits are valid for parking in any lot on campus.
- Parking permits allow guests to park in any unmarked parking space on campus.

Payment Options

Parking permit kiosks accept credit cards, ATM cards, cash and quarters.

- If paying with cash, guest must *pay the exact amount*. Otherwise, a voucher for the overpaid amount can be obtained from the CSUN Campus Police Department Office to receive a refund.

Other Parking Options

Street parking is also available on some streets around the university, subject to posted restrictions.
