Inquiry Spirals

- "Starter: Pick up "talking stone", repeat the question and hand the stone to the person to your left.
- When you receive the stone pause and reflect.
 Listen for whatever response emerges. Let your intuition speak to you.
- Offer the response that emerges to the group.

Inquiry Spirals (cont.)

- When complete, pause and reflect again. Listen for the next question that wants to be asked.
 (Note: from within you)
- State the question that emerges and pass it and the stone to the person on your left.
- Continue the pattern around the table.
- If you complete a round before you hear the chime, continue.
